

Your tithes, offerings, and donations can now be **made online.** Tithing and donating have never been easier. It's quick, easy and secure and you can use debit or credit or check cards, or checking account. For more information, go to collegestreetbaptist.org.

Online giving is not replacing any of the ways we already give, but is an additional option to those who prefer to make their donations by computer, cell phone or other mobile devices. College Street is using a church donation system provided by the Easy Tithe corporation. EasyTithe is church specific and is currently used by hundreds of churches across the nation.

You can make a regularly scheduled contribution or you can specify recurring donations. You can specify whether the contribution should go to the general budget or to designated categories. A credit card (MasterCard, Visa, or Discover) or a debit card can be used as well as a regular checking account. The process is secure and confidential and you will have continual access to your giving records.
